Review Income/Expenditures

Bank Balance is still big...a lot of money in and very little spent

Revenue

- \$16,000 revenue from the Fun Runapproximately 10% of revenue was paid back to the online service we used
- Innisbrook is still missing a bill. Parents indicated that the shipments have been arriving this week, which is later than anticipated.

- Waiting for revenue on The Vine Dine & Share from November
