Playground Equipment

There was an assumption that each class would get to pick their own equipment, however there was consensus that the equipment should be shared amongst all grades to reduce volume purchased as well as to minimize cluttering in each classroom. WOW Fun Run

Totals were highlighted during the Treasurer Report.
